## COACH EXTERNAL SPORT CREDENTIALS PROGRAM STANDARDS

The student coach must fulfill the following requirements to receive credits for **Coach 11**

- NCCP Community Sport Initiation;
- NCCP Making Ethical Decisions “evaluated”; and
- 30 hours of coaching experience monitored and reviewed by an Introduction to Competition “certified” coach or NCCP Level 2 “certified” coach in the sport you are being evaluated in.

### DOCUMENTATION

Student coaches seeking to earn credit under the **Coach 11** category must ensure they have completed all the required components and send their proof of completion (copy of NCCP certifications, practical coach experience verification letter and Make-Ethical Decisions “evaluated”) to the Sport and Recreation Branch. The Sport and Recreation Branch representative will review the submitted documentation and issue a verification letter directly to the student if the student has fulfilled all the requirements.

Make Ethical Decisions “evaluated” – once a student coach receives an NCCP # from the Coaches Association of Canada (CAC), they can request a username and password from the CAC that will allow them to then complete the “Evaluation” portion of Make Ethical Decisions module.
